RESOLUTION NO. 18-0511

**AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO APPOINT A MUNICIPAL  
HUMANE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

**WHEREAS**, recently enacted state law, N.J. Public Law 2017, Chapter 331, transferred responsibilities for enforcement of animal cruelty laws in the state from the New Jersey Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (“NJSPCA”) and County Societies for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (“County Societies”) to a County Prosecutor Animal Cruelty Task Force in each county of the state and a Municipal Humane Law Enforcement Officer in each municipality; and


**WHEREAS**, the Monmouth County Prosecutor’s Office, in recognition of this recent statutory requirement, have directed municipalities to appoint a designated member of each police department to serve as Municipal Humane Law Enforcement Officer; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Wall Township Committee, on the advice of Wall Township Police Chief Ken Brown, believe that Wall Township Police Lt. Chad Clark should serve as the Municipal Humane Law Enforcement Officer and in this position he will be authorized to enforce, investigate, and sign complaints concerning any violation of the animal cruelty laws of the state or ordinances of the municipality, and to act as an officer for the detection, apprehension, and arrest of offenders against the animal welfare and animal cruelty laws of the State and ordinances of the municipality; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE** be it resolved by the Wall Township Governing Body that Lt. Chad Clark be appointed as Municipal Humane Law Enforcement Officer for the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, with no compensation; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Wall Township Administrator and Clerk are authorized to take whatever ministerial action is necessary to effectuate the goals of this Resolution.
