
WHEREAS, the Township of Wall was named as co-defendant in a legal action initiated by the Shark River Cleanup Coalition for alleged failure to protect a water pipe from natural elements that could damage said water pipe; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall desires enter onto property owned by the Estate of Fred McDowell to access the Wall Township owned easement where the water pipe is situated to assess the pipe and potentially perform mitigation of the underlying condition; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Wall Township Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a hold harmless agreement in favor of the Estate of Fred McDowell; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
