RESOLUTION NO. 18-0922

AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO ENTER INTO RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENTS AUTHORIZING COUNTY OF MONMOUTH EMPLOYEES AND EQUIPMENT TO ENTER UPON TOWNSHIP PROPERTY FOR EMERGENCY BRIDGE MAINTENANCE OF BRIDGE W-55 AND BRIDGE W-56 ON MARCONI ROAD

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall recognizes that its resident motorists as well as other motorists depend on a safe transportation infrastructure on all roads and bridges located within Wall Township; and,

WHEREAS, Monmouth County is the owner and responsible party for the maintenance and upkeep of the W-55 Bridge located on Marconi Road over tributary to Shark River and Bridge W-56 on Marconi Road over Laurel Gully Brook in Wall Township; and,


WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth has requested permission to enter upon Wall Township property to make emergency repairs and construction activities on these Bridges; and,

WHEREAS, Monmouth County has agreed to save and hold harmless the Township from any claims arising from their use of the property and have agreed to restore the property to its original condition; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer, Mr. Zahorsky, has recommended that the Township execute the Agreements with Monmouth County to insure that necessary repairs are conducted; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, New Jersey that Mr. Zahorsky, the Municipal Engineer, is authorized to execute two Emergency Right of Entry Agreements dated September 20, 2018 permitting the County of Monmouth to enter upon Township property and that members of the Wall Township Administration are authorized to take such ministerial action as is necessary to effectuate the goals of this Resolution; and,
