**RESOLUTION NO. 21-0214**

**AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE A NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION APPLICATION FOR A UTILITY OPENING PERMIT FOR  
1861 HIGHWAY 35 AKA BLOCK 279, LOT 29**

**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications have been prepared for the purpose of providing water and sewer services for new construction on Block 279, Lot 29; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with the aforesaid project, the Township of Wall is required to endorse any and all utility opening permit applications it submits to the New Jersey Department of Transportation (“NJDOT”); and


**WHEREAS**, plans and specifications for the project have been reviewed by the Township Engineer and the Township Committee finds that it would be in the best interest of the Township and in the public interest to authorize the endorsement of the Township to the aforesaid utility opening permit; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the Township to submit the NJDOT application it must be signed by the Township Administrator; and

**WHEREAS**, the owner shall be responsible for all application fees, inspection fees, performance bonds and any other associates’ fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Township Committee hereby authorize the Township Administrator to sign the NJDOT application for the street opening application for 1861 Highway 35 a/k/a Block 279, Lot 29 so it can be submitted to NJDOT.
