

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**RESOLUTION 21-0320**

**AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE A RECIPROCAL MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN WALL TOWNSHIP EMS AND BOROUGH OF BELMAR EMS**

**WHEREAS**, mutual aid and assistance agreements between municipalities, counties, law enforcement agencies police, Emergency Medical Service, fire departments, fire companies or EMS organizations and fire departments situated in fire districts operated by a Board of Fire Commissioners, are permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-26 and 40A: 14-156.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Belmar EMS and the Wall Township EMS recognize the necessity to cooperate and work together to provide mutual aid and contingency assistance to the surrounding communities and at times may need to receive the same assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall entered into a Shared Services Agreement with Belmar First Aid Squad, Inc., on August 1, 2018 through July 31, 2023, with an option to extend additional five (5) years with the mutual consent of the aforementioned parties to the Shared Services Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, as of April 1, 2021, Belmar First Aid Squad, Inc., will no longer exist and will be replaced by the Borough of Belmar EMS; and


**WHEREAS**, the Township of Wall and the Borough of Belmar wish to enter into a reciprocal Mutual Aid Agreement under terms substantially similar to those set forth in the August 1, 2018 Shared Services Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the residents of Wall Township to enter a mutual aid and assistance agreement between Wall Township EMS and Borough of Belmar EMS to provide for emergency medical services in the event that the entities in the respective jurisdiction are unavailable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wall, County of Monmouth, New Jersey that the Township of Wall are authorized to enter contract between Wall Township EMS and Borough of Belmar EMS, a copy of which is attached hereto, on the terms and conditions contained therein; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all Township officials including, but not limited to the Mayor, the Township Administrator and the Municipal Clerk, are hereby authorized and directed to take such ministerial actions as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.
