

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-0406**

**AUTHORIZATION FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL TO APPLY FOR  
AVAILABLE FUNDS THE SFY21 BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2020, Chapter 128 (approved November 24, 2020) requires that all uniformed patrol officers be equipped with body worn cameras; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wall Township Police Department is required to be in compliance with the State body worn camera program; and

**WHEREAS**, in P.L. 2020, Chapter 142 the State appropriated \$58,000,000 for grants-in-aid to support the statewide body worn camera program; and

**WHEREAS**, in NJSA 52:14-34.4e the Attorney General indicates that the application must be completed no later than April 30, 2021 for the SFY21 Body-Worn Camera Grant Program; and


**WHEREAS**, Chief Brown has reviewed available options for body worn cameras and has found a company that can provide the equipment to ensure that the Wall Township Police Department will be in compliance with the State body worn camera program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires for the Police Department to be in compliance with the State requirements;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township of Wall that the Police Department is authorized to apply for the SFY21 Body-Worn Camera Grant Program for the purchase of the equipment needed to be in compliance with the State body worn camera program;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Township officials are authorized to take such action as is necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
