

TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 24-2007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 36, "POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 36, "Police Department" of the Code of the Township of Wall, Section 36-1, "Membership", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of subsections 36-1C, 36-1D and 36-1E and the substitution therefor of the following:

"C. A Lieutenant, with not less than one year's experience as Sergeant First Class of the Police Department, and such other qualifications as may be prescribed by the Township Administrator, the number to be appointed as may be necessary.

D. A Sergeant First Class, with not less than one year's experience as a Sergeant of the Police Department, and such other qualifications as may be prescribed by the Township Administrator, the number to be appointed as may be necessary.

E. A Sergeant, with not less than three year's experience as a member of the Police Department, and such other qualifications as may be prescribed by the Township Administrator, the number to be appointed as may be necessary."

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect or impair the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 4. The Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
