

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 32-2006**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING CHAPTER 191, THE "SOLID WASTE REGULATIONS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL," OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, VARIOUS SECTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 191 of the "Solid Waste Regulations of the Township of Wall", as amended and supplemented, Section 191-3 entitled, "Preparation for collection," Paragraphs C and L shall be deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

"C. Ashes. Ashes shall not be collected."

"L. Needles. Needles shall not be collected."

Section 2. Section 191 of the "Solid Waste Regulations of the Township of Wall", as amended and supplemented, Section 191-4 entitled, "Garbage receptacles," shall be amended so as to supplement the title which shall now read as follows:

"§191-4. Garbage and Co-Mingle receptacles. "

Section 3. Section 191 of the "Solid Waste Regulations of the Township of Wall", as amended and supplemented, Section 191-4 entitled, "Garbage receptacles," shall be amended and supplemented so as to create new Paragraphs G and H which shall read as follows:

"G. The owner, resident, tenant, lessee or occupant of every residential dwelling shall provide and keep on such premises sufficient and

suitable metal or plastic receptacles or containers not exceeding 32 gallons in capacity with tight fitting covers, for receiving and holding co-mingle.

- H. All receptacles used for the purposes described in Section 191-11, All co-mingle receptacles shall be properly labeled with the labels provided by the Township. Co-mingle shall be placed at the curb with the label facing the street for collection. Plastic bags shall not be used for a co-mingle receptacle.”

Section 4. Section 191 of the “Solid Waste Regulations of the Township of Wall”, as amended and supplemented, Section 191-11 entitled, “Residential recycling receptacles,” shall be amended and supplemented so as to create a new Paragraph F which shall read as follows:

“F. Household plastic bottles, cans and etc.”

Section 5. Section 191 of the “Solid Waste Regulations of the Township of Wall”, as amended and supplemented, Section 191-12 entitled, “Commercial and industrial recycling,” shall be amended and supplemented so as to create a new Paragraph H which shall be read as follows:

“H. Plastic bottles, cans and etc.”

Section 6. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on October 11, 2006, and will further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on November 21, 2006, at 7:30 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
