

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL****ORDINANCE NO. 08-2006**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 36, "POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL.**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 36, "Police Department" of the Code of the Township of Wall, Section 36-6, "Applicability of Rules to Police Personnel", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of subsection 36-6 and the substitution therefor of the following:

"36-6. Establishment of Appropriate Authority and Promulgation of Rules and Regulations Regarding the Government and Discipline of Members of the Police Department.

(1) The Township Administrator shall be designated as the appropriate authority, as provided in the New Jersey statutes (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118), for the promulgation of rules and regulations. The Township Administrator shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for the government of the Police Department and for the discipline of its members.

(2) The Chief of Police shall be the head of the Police Department and shall be directly responsible to the Township Administrator for its efficiency and day to day operations. Pursuant to policies established by the Township Administrator, the Chief of Police shall:

- a. Administer and enforce the rules and regulations of the Police Department and any special emergency directives for the disposition and discipline of the Department and its members and officers;
- b. Have, exercise and discharge the functions, powers and duties of the Police Department;
- c. Prescribe the duties and assignments of all members and officers;
- d. Delegate such authority as may be deemed necessary for the efficient operation of the Police Department to be exercised under the Chief's direction and control; and
- e. Report at least weekly to the Township Administrator in such form as shall be prescribed on the operation of the Police Department during the preceding week and make such other reports as may be requested by the Township Administrator.”

**Section 2.** All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 3.** Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect or impair the remainder of the Ordinance.

**Section 4.** The Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on March 8, 2006, and further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on April 12, 2006, at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to members of the general public who shall request the same.
