**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A VACTOR VEHICLE FOR THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT AND APPROPRIATING \$245,000 THEREFOR, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township") has determined to purchase a Vactor vehicle for the Water and Sewer Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has \$245,000 available from the Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as water/sewer improvements to be undertaken in and by the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township"). For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated \$245,000, said sum being funded from the Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized to be undertaken consist of the purchase of a Vactor vehicle for the Water and Sewer Department, together with all purposes necessary, incidental or appurtenant thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with contracts, plans, specifications or requisitions therefor on file with or through the Township Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the Township.

Section 3. The 2005 capital budget of the Township will conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. The Township Attorney and other Township officials and representatives are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to accomplish the purposes of the appropriation made herein.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
