ORDINANCE NO. 46-2002

AS AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL PERTAINING TO CONDITIONAL USE REGULATIONS -RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter XIV, "Land Use and Development", of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977, as amended and supplemented, Article IV, entitled, "Zoning", Section 14-405.2, "Conditional Uses", subsection 14-405.2.(15), "Religious Organizations (SIC 866)", be and the same is hereby amended and supplemented to delete subparagraph (e) pertaining to supplemental zoning regulations, to delete subsection 14.-405.2(15)(e)(1) and to substitute therefor the following:

"(1) Maximum impervious coverage shall not exceed 30%."

<u>Section 2.</u> All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

<u>Section 3</u>, Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.
