

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL**

**ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 2000**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE VII, (THROUGH STREETS) OF SECTION 7-6.1, "THROUGH STREETS;" AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE VIII (STOP INTERSECTIONS) OF SECTION 7-6.2, "STOP INTERSECTION," OF CHAPTER 7 (TRAFFIC) OF "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED", PERTAINING TO WILLIAMSBURG DRIVE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 7-6.1, entitled "Through Streets," of Chapter VII (Traffic) of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977," as amended and supplemented, provides in pertinent part that: "[T]he streets are a part of streets described in Schedule VII attached to and made part of this Chapter are hereby designated as Through Streets"; and

**WHEREAS**, after a field inspection and on-site review, it has been determined by the Police Department and the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic and Engineering Safety Programs, that there are several roadways in the Township that should be designated as "Through Streets," and appropriate stop signs to be erected on the near right side of each intersection with the said through streets, or YIELD signs are provided for designation, in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-6.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee now wishes to amend and supplement Schedule VII in order to effectuate the designations of these new Through Streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee on September 13, 2000, adopted Ordinance No. 24-2000 which contained a "through street" designation pertaining to

Williamsburg Drive which, due to a typographical error, contained an incorrect description of the limits of the aforesaid through street;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section VII, "Through Streets", of Section 7.6-1, entitled "Through Streets," of Chapter VII (Traffic) of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977," as amended and supplemented, is hereby further amended and supplemented in order to designate the following roadways, or parts of roadways, as through streets within the township, with appropriate STOP signs to be erected on the near right side of each street intersecting with the through streets:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>LIMITS</u>
"Williamsburg Drive	Between Baileys Corner Road and Westerly Terminus of Williamsburg Drive"

Section 2. The provisions of Ordinance No. 24-2000 of the Township of Wall finally adopted on September 13, 2000 pertaining to the designation of Williamsburg Drive as a through street, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Should any section, paragraph, clause or other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall effect upon its passage and publication

according to law, but not before approval of the same by the Commission of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on November 13, 2000, and further be considered for final passage and adopted at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey on December 13, 2000, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to members of the general public who shall request the same.
