

## TOWNSHIP OF WALL

## ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SCHEDULE III, "NO STOPPING OR STANDING," OF SECTION 7-3.5 "STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS," OF CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC," OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977," AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, PERTAINING TO A NO STOPPING OR STANDING PROHIBITION ON RAMSHORN DRIVE.

**WHEREAS**, "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, Section 7-3.5, "Parking or Standing Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets", provides that "[N]o person shall stop or stand a vehicle between the hours specified on Schedule III of any day (except Sundays and public holidays) on any of the streets or parts or streets described in Schedule III attached hereto and made a part of this Chapter"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department has recommended an addition to the street schedule in Schedule III;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall as follows:

Section 1. Chapter VII, "Traffic", Section 7-3.5 "Stopping or Standing Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets", Schedule III, "No Stopping or Standing", be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by addition thereto of the following:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>LOCATION &amp; SIZE</u>	<u>HOURS</u>
"Ramshorn Drive	Entire Length excluding the following:	Anytime
	A) A point between 25 feet to 240 feet south from Paynters Road on the northbound side.	
	B) A point between 583 feet to 1444 feet north from Paynters Road on the northbound side.	
	C) A point between 3120 feet to 3680 feet north from Paynters Road on the northbound side."	

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3. Should any Section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance by a Court of competent jurisdiction be deemed invalid, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.

NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on July 14, 1999 and will be further considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on August 11, 1999 at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to, and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall to members of the general public who shall request the same.
