

**TOWNSHIP OF WALL
ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 1998**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION", SECTION 2-8, "RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE", SUBSECTION 2-8.3, "MEMBERSHIP", OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WALL, 1977," AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED PERTAINING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. "Chapter II, "Administration", Section 2-8, "Recreation Advisory Committee; subsection 2-8.3, "Membership", of "The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Wall, 1977", as amended and supplemented, be and the same is hereby further amended and supplemented by the deletion therefrom of subparagraph 2-8.3a. and the substitution therefor of the following:

"a. The Recreation Advisory Committee shall consist of seven residents of the Township appointed by the Township Committee. Three members of the Recreation Advisory Committee shall be appointed for three year terms. The remaining four members of the Recreation Advisory Committee shall consist of the president of the Wall Soccer Club, the president of the North Wall Little League, the president of the South Wall Little League and the president of Wall Pop Warner, Inc. The individuals who hold those positions shall be appointed by the Township Committee to the Recreation Advisory Committee for one year terms. Should any such appointee cease to hold the office of president of the organization which he or she represents, the appointment will terminate and the then current president of the applicable organization shall be appointed as a member of the Recreation Advisory

Committee. In 1998 only, there shall be eight members of the Recreation Advisory Committee due to the current terms of office of the members previously appointed.”

Section 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3. Should any section, paragraph, clause or any other portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not effect or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law, retroactive to January 1, 1998.

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Wall on February 11, 1998 and will further be considered for final passage and adoption at the Wall Township Municipal Building, 2700 Allaire Road, Wall, New Jersey, on March 11, 1998 at 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, at which time and place all persons interested therein shall be given an opportunity to be heard, and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office in the Township of Wall, Town Hall, to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
